- **All round development of students:**

Students participate in helping the marginalized sections of the society like orphans and elderly people. Students help children by organizing classes for children in orphanages. Students help in the old age home.


• **Physical Development:**

The institute promotes physical activity among the students to develop many important skills like physical fitness, team spirit, self-confidence, decision-making ability, mental strength etc. Every year, the institute organizes annual sports competitions for the students which include various sports like Cricket, Volleyball, Table Tennis, Kabaddi, Kho Kho, Chess, Carom etc. Both boys and girls participate in these games and show their skills – their sportsmanship. and enhance team building capabilities. • **Emotional Development:**

Emotional health of students is given due attention in the institution. A mentor-mentee system is in place which ensures students interact with teachers at least once every two weeks. During these meetings, students can discuss their academic as well as personal problems with the faculty. Students are given proper counseling by teachers. The institute has special mentors for a group of 15-20 students who regularly meet the girl-students, understand their difficulties, if any, and guide

them on possible solutions. A vocational counselor is also appointed in the institute who can be helped by needy students.
